

ENGLISH LITERATURE

In the first half of this exam candidates are required to write a short analysis of an unseen poem. From time to time, two short poems are set, and candidates are invited to compare and contrast the poems.

In the second half of the exam candidates are required to write an essay on one of their GCSE/IGCSE texts. The questions from which they can choose may be applied to any of the drama or prose texts they have studied. Good detailed knowledge of the text will be necessary; the texts themselves are not allowed in the exam.
