## NIGHTINGALES CHILDREN'S PROJECT

### About the Charity:

- ▶ When Romania joined the UN it decided that it would no longer provide for HIV positive children within the orphanage system
- ▶ Nightingales started out as the 'home of happiness' which was set up for HIV positive children from the local orphanage.
- ▶ Now the charity runs a programme for local teenage boys and girls who are at risk of being involved in trafficking
- ▶ The Charity works closely with the girls at risk of being trafficked by educating them and providing employment
  - ▶ Supports children in the local area
- ▶ Provides independent living accommodation for young adults from the old orphanage
  - ▶ Provides care for young adults with HIV
- ▶ Our trip provides the charity with over half of their annual income



## Fundraising

Throughout the year we run a variety of fundraising events which in the past have generated up to £15,000 – over half of the Charity’s annual income.

### Where does the funding go?

- £5 a day provides food for the girls at risk programme so that they can have a snack/meal before/after school.
- £10 the salary a day for one of the young men in the mentoring scheme.
- £15 a day provides lunch for our handicapped adults.
- £30 a month keeps a girl in the anti-trafficking programme.
- £60 a month the salary of the part time worker for the girls at risk project, everyone else in this project is voluntary.
- £80 lets us run a party for 35 local children at the Nightingales coffee shop.
