Academic Scholarship testing

Academic references from current schools will be requested. Alternative arrangements for sitting papers will be made as necessary and academic interviews will be online via Microsoft Teams.

Boarding Award

We kindly request a detailed CV outlining interests, achievements and abilities and an online interview will be scheduled via Microsoft Teams.

Sport Award assessments

Your detailed sporting CV will be very important if you are not able to attend a practical assessment. We would also like to see testimonials from teachers and/or coaches in support of your application. Where possible, the Director of Sport will attend club matches, to see candidates 'in action'.

Performing Arts Award assessments

You may be asked to attend a live audition via Microsoft Teams, or to submit a single-take video recording of the chosen pieces being performed, followed by an interview and aural testing (for music) live via Teams. A detailed CV will also be required.
