What does loyalty mean to you?

The theme could be interpreted in a number of ways. You may already have your own idea, but here are some possible starting points:

- *a project about, or portrait of, the most loyal human or animal you know*
- *your experience of being in a team - what loyalty feels like*
- *an historical project - how loyalty to an idea brought about change*
- *a narrative based on the theme in prose, poetry, drama, dance, film or animation*
- *a publicity campaign to grow support for a local team or club*
- *a project about a team or individual to whom you are loyal - and why you feel this way about them...*



The Low Down

Your project could take any form and be created in any discipline. It could be a study that focusses on facts or an entirely creative piece. Past entries to the prize have included musical compositions, animations, cakes, paintings, posters, study books, creative writing, sculpture, dance routines, dramatic monologues...

If your piece is a performance, you should submit a recording.
